The NIEA Business Network is a national platform that the Nishati Initiative East Africa (NIEA) curated to identify, amplify, and support Uganda's most credible, impact-driven businesses. With a special emphasis on women and youth-led enterprises, the network connects growth-ready businesses to visibility, partnerships, and capital beyond traditional financing instruments.

The platform aims to close critical gaps in enterprise visibility, investor readiness, and access to strategic growth support. It ensures that Uganda's most promising businesses are well-positioned to scale sustainably and competitively.

Vision

To build a trusted ecosystem of credible Ugandan enterprises that solve real problems, create dignified work, and drive inclusive economic growth across priority sectors.

Target Profile

The network targets registered Ugandan businesses that meet the following criteria:

- Women- or youth-led, where applicable
- Demonstrated market traction, community impact, and clear growth potential
- Actively seeking investment, strategic partnerships, or market entry support
- Operating in high-potential sectors, including but not limited to:
 - Clean and renewable energy
 - Agribusiness and agro-processing
 - Artificial intelligence and advanced digital technologies
 - Light and heavy manufacturing
 - o Technical trades such as welding, pipefitting, fabrication, and engineering services

- Circular economy and waste-to-value models
- o Logistics and supply chain optimisation
- Health-tech, EdTech, and other socially relevant business models

What the Platform Offers

How the Platform Works

1. Call for Applications

NIEA periodically invites enterprises to express interest in joining the network through a guided application process.

2. Screening and Curation

Applications are reviewed to assess credibility, readiness, and alignment with the platform's objectives. Selected enterprises are officially onboarded.

3. Showcasing and Promotion

Member businesses are profiled and promoted through NIEA's digital assets, newsletters, and partner platforms.

4. Brokered Connections

NIEA facilitates tailored linkages to capital providers, buyers, grantmakers, and ecosystem enablers.

5. Capacity Building and Strategic Opportunities

Members receive invitations to participate in technical clinics, business dialogues, and training sessions hosted or co-hosted by NIEA.

6. Enterprise Tracking and Insight Sharing

Member businesses are tracked over time to generate insights and aggregate learning that informs national enterprise policy and development support.
